

Coloured Courts

There can be no more than three different colours on the floor and wall playing surfaces within the court.

Each of the side walls shall be of the same colour.

The front wall may be two colours, one below and one above the service line. The front wall colours need not be the same colour as the side walls.

All colours are to have a minimum reflectance value of 50% and all colours must be of the same reflectance value + or - 10%

Colours are permitted on all new and existing courts providing that the average illumination does not fall below the recommended standard of 500 lux or the minimum standard of 300 lux.

Stripes or patterns of any type will not be permitted on the wall playing surfaces except on the front wall at a minimum height of 3600 mm above the floor where a logo, club or sponsors name may be used provided it is not more than 750 mm square and is located central on the front wall.

The minimum reflectance value of any of the colours used in any name or logo shall be 30%

The tin may be of any colour and contain advertising, logos, club or sponsors names providing no part has a reflectance value of less than 30%

Before painting existing court walls they should be thoroughly cleaned with Resene Graffiti Cleaner and any flaking paint must be sanded off and cracks and holes filled with an Epoxy filler.
